SPOTLIGHT ON GHANA

Ghana has firmly held on to democracy in a region full of dictators and coups. With a high life expectancy, it's blessed with many natural resources, and major exports keep the economy going despite recent struggles with inflation and unemployment. This month, AE will hold an important mission in Ghana's capital city, Accra, a vibrant metropolis.

- 1 Pray for AE Ghana's Team leader, Ben Sachie, as he guides his team through the next few months.
- 2 Today marks the beginning of four days of special prayer for the whole of African Enterprise: praise God for AE! May God be glorified!
- 3 Pray for AE's leaders – may God grant them wisdom in their decisions and strength for their work. We are grateful for all they do!
- 4 Pray for the families of AE Ghana's staff – may God be their protector and provider.
- 5 Today is the final Mission Planning Committee meeting for the upcoming Accra Mission: pray for the last preparations to come together, for God's presence throughout the process.
- 6 Pray for the final fundraising efforts for the mission to be successful with local and international fundraising.
- 7 Pray for the president of Ghana, Nana Akufo-Addo, who has been in office for just under a year; may he rule justly and wisely.
- 8 Ghana's media is relatively free and radio is popular – pray for new ways to spread the Gospel through radio, newspaper and other media outlets.
- 9 Pray for the spread of Islam to be stopped – particularly in the north of the country where its influence is strongest.
- 10 Pray for the Gospel to reach Ghana's young people, that their hearts would be open to receive Christ and impact their country.
- 11 Pray for those who claim to know Christ but whose faith is shallow: may they come to know and believe the truth deep inside their hearts.
- 12 Pray for the Global Evangelists Forum happening today and tomorrow in Ghana, that it would be encouraging and uplifting to those gathered.
- 13 Pray for a movement of the Holy Spirit during the mission next week, that many lives will be touched.
- 14 Pray for church leaders in Accra South as their support and encouragement is vital to the success to the mission – may they mobilise their members to partake in the mission.
- 15 We thank God for the Mission Working Committee members, for their sacrifice, time and energy. May God bless them and give them strength.
- 16 Pray for local missionaries to take the Gospel into villages and unreached areas of Ghana where indigenous, animist beliefs are still held.
- 17 Pray for the AE mission team and volunteers; for divine protection, strength and the covering of Jesus's blood before, during and after the mission.
- 18 Pray that God would speak to people through the film evangelism taking place over the next four days as a precursor to the mission – may He prepare people's hearts!
- 19 Pray for Rev. Sakyi-Yorke, Local Coordinator, for the entire mission; pray that God would give him wisdom as he coordinates and oversees all mission activities.
- 20 Today is the Accra South Mission Orientation: pray for a powerful beginning and movement of the Holy Spirit through all who gather!
- 21 Today is the mission street cleaning and street march – may it witness to people of all backgrounds and religions, telling of God's love and care.
- 22 Pray that the churches in Accra South will work together in unity to share the Gospel of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
- 23 Pray for the favour of God to be on the leadership meetings taking place this week.
- 24 Pray for every evangelistic meeting and for open doors for mission workers to share the Gospel.
- 25 Pray for God's hand on each of the Outreach Zones being targeted: Odorkor, Dansoman, Kwashieman, Sowotuum, Kaneshie and Bubuashie.
- 26 Pray for the Lord's blessing on the speakers this week; may God's voice speak through them.
- 27 Pray for the government leaders, business leaders and civil servants of Accra to see and be changed by the Gospel movement in their city.
- 28 Today is the medical outreach of the mission: pray for the medical team to be God's healers, and that those healed may praise God.
- 29 Today is the closing rally of the mission: may it leave an impression in the hearts and minds of the people of Accra.
- 30 Pray for the mission follow-up over the next week to be effective.
- 31 Pray for Accra's churches to keep the fire of the mission going and to disciple those new to the faith.



EVANGELISING THE CITIES OF AFRICA THROUGH
WORD AND DEED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CHURCH

**AUG****SPOTLIGHT ON NORTH AFRICA AND SOUTH SUDAN**

Together let's pray the work in these areas will have a significant impact on lives for the Gospel. The Go North Initiative in North Africa, is making inroads for the Gospel in areas like Tunisia whose population is 98% Muslim. In South Sudan, our Peace and Reconciliation workshops are changing perspectives and challenging those of different tribes to work together to live in peace.

- 1 Join us as we thank God for the love and provision He has shown to believers in house churches and small congregations across North African countries.
- 2 Thank God for our passionate 'Go North' partners who are so passionate about sharing their faith in the Muslim world.
- 3 Pray God would continue to strengthen and embolden the North African believers to live and witness for Him even during government restrictions.
- 4 'Go North' aims to partner with to partner with and equip the Sub-Saharan Africans, churches and ministries with North African (NA) counterparts. Pray Sub-Saharan Africans would catch the vision and respond to the call to minister in NA.
- 5 Pray for strong links between believers in Northern and Southern Africa. Pray many would be moved to actual involvement in the NA mission field.
- 6 Pray for ongoing work with pastors in nearby nations like Cote d'Ivoire, which is strategic for ministry in NA. Ask God to give them a heart for their neighbours.
- 7 Praise God for the success in introducing North African pastors and ministers to Sub-Saharan leaders this year. Pray bonds would grow and the Gospel is advanced through these connections.
- 8 Pray for the Carthage Experience taking place in November. Churches across Africa will gather to hear from NA pastors and ministers about the challenge of sharing the Gospel in NA. Please pray for the elections in Kenya today.
- 9 Pray the Carthage Experience will result in Sub-Saharan leaders taking hold of the Go North call.
- 10 FOCUS – Kenya and AE are partnering to facilitate a student's mission conference to see thousands of students across Africa come together in December for evangelism training. Pray this would yield much fruit on college campuses.
- 11 Pray for the believers in North Africa, for strength and wisdom as they share their faith with nonbelievers and Muslims.
- 12 Pray Sub-Saharan Africans would fully embrace the call to reach out to their neighbours in North Africa with the Gospel.
- 13 Ask God for wisdom for Stephen Mbogo, AE CEO/ITL, and Emmanuel Kwizera, AE Int'l Missions Director, as they work to create strong links for Gospel opportunity among the North and South of Africa.
- 14 Pray peace would reign in these nations, and terrorism would be stamped out wherever it is found.
- 15 Pray people would look beyond tribal differences in South Sudan and make

peace with each other as neighbours.

- 16 Pray for the Christians in South Sudan's Parliament committed to peace and national stability. Pray AE's National Prayer Breakfasts would touch the hearts of national leaders.
- 17 AE's Youth Life Skills training is a proposed program to equip youth to facilitate peace in their communities and effectively share the Gospel. Pray for funding and wisdom as we move forward.
- 18 Pray for the millions of refugees who have fled South Sudan as we minister to them in Kenyan and Ugandan camps. Pray God would heal their hearts and minds from the horrors they have seen.
- 19 Pray for boldness for the grassroots leaders who have completed AE's Peace and Reconciliation training.
- 20 Pray God's favour for AE staff as they work within the South Sudanese government to encourage righteous godly leadership among parliament leaders.
- 21 Pray God would protect William Muchiri and other AE Kenya staff as they travel to South Sudan for ministry.
- 22 Pray for the young leaders who are emerging amid such terrible unrest. Ask God to guide them to godly mentors to influence their leadership.
- 23 Pray for those who will complete the Peace and Reconciliation training this year. Ask God to make a deep and lasting change in their hearts.
- 24 The government has granted AE land for a school and training centre in Juba! Ask for God's favour as we continue to fundraise and plan for this long-term project.
- 25 Pray that those who plot wickedness and violence against their neighbours in South Sudan would instead be enlightened by the Gospel.
- 26 Pray God would elevate the voices of those who promote peace in the nation and increase their platform.
- 27 Pray peace would reign in the nation of South Sudan and that people would repent of their sins and turn to righteousness.
- 28 Thank God for the AE donors who have given toward AE's South Sudan ministry. Pray for God's provision as we begin new initiatives.
- 29 Thank God for hearts radically changed and healed through AE's Peace and Reconciliation courses. Help them to speak boldly about the experience to others.
- 30 Pray local churches will preach peace and reconciliation, not division.
- 31 Ask God to protect the peacemakers in South Sudan from harm.

**SEP****SPOTLIGHT ON UGANDA**

This month we focus on Uganda and on the mission taking place in its capital city, Kampala, at the end of the month. Join us as we pray for this rapidly growing nation and buzzing capital city; may God be glorified and may the people of Kampala praise His name!

- 1 Pray for the President of Uganda, Yoweri Museveni, that he would be fair and selfless in running the country, and that God's will would be worked out through him.
- 2 Pray for Team Leader of Uganda, Paul Ssembiro, for strength in his work for the Gospel.
- 3 Pray for the Thanksgiving Rally in Malindi Kenya today – praise God for the souls who came to Him in June! May they continue to grow in their faith.
- 4 Pray for AE's work with the refugees of South Sudan living in camps in Uganda. May we find more ways of reaching them with the Good News of Christ.
- 5 Pray for the deteriorating healthcare conditions in Uganda, and for those in rural areas who lack access to hospitals and resources. May God be their healer and provider!
- 6 Pray for the poor of Uganda who lack access to education. Pray especially for girls who are less able to get to school that they have the opportunity to learn and read about Jesus.
- 7 Pray for the public perception of the Church in Uganda, which has received negative attention recently – may true Christians be a light to those living in darkness.
- 8 Pray for unity in the Church in Uganda – that different denominations would respect each other and work together to enhance the kingdom.
- 9 Much of Uganda is Christian, but there is a growing Muslim population. Pray for local missionaries to go into Muslim communities with the love of Christ.
- 10 Pray God would prepare the hearts of those in Kampala to be open to the Gospel.
- 11 Pray a recent 'noise control law' would not hinder the preaching of the Gospel at the Kampala mission next week.
- 12 Pray the Kampala Mission Steering Committee would be united in purpose as they implement the final details of the mission.
- 13 Pray for the mission training happening today with AE Uganda staff – may the Lord prepare them and fill them with zeal for His name!
- 14 Today AE Ghana has an important missions planning committee meeting for the Accra Mission next month – pray for God's guidance.
- 15 The Kampala City Mission starts today! Pray for all rallies and meetings this week to bring many souls to Christ.

- 16 Pray for local churches in Kampala that their leaders and members would work with AE in the next few weeks to disciple people of the city.
- 17 Pray the youth of Kampala would hear the Gospel this week and come to a saving knowledge of Christ through AE's work.
- 18 Pray for the Social Action ministry taking place in Kampala; may people see Christ's love in action.
- 19 Pray God would speak through each evangelist who preaches at the mission this week.
- 20 Pray for all the difficult counselling issues that will come up through the mission. May God give wisdom to the volunteers, church members and staff who speak to the lost.
- 21 International Day of Peace: Pray that countries plagued by bloodshed and chaos would be free of violence and that God would bring His peace to them.
- 22 Pray against any efforts by the enemy to thwart the work of God's people at the Kampala mission!
- 23 Pray the government leaders, business leaders and civil servants of Kampala would hear and be changed by the Gospel this week.
- 24 As the Kampala Mission comes to an end, pray that the closing rally would leave a powerful impression on the city.
- 25 Pray for AE's ministry to the University of Kampala – may its students and professors come to know Jesus.
- 26 Pray for all new converts in Kampala to be adopted into caring local churches where they can be effectively discipled.
- 27 Pray that the Christians of Uganda would continue to feel the spirit of evangelism even after the Kampala mission is complete – that they would spread the fire of the Gospel throughout the country.
- 28 Thank God for all those who worked hard during the Kampala mission. May God bless them and give them continued passion for His work!
- 29 Pray for AE Ethiopia's Youth Mission starting today until 2 October – may God touch the hearts of that country's youth and bring them to salvation.
- 30 Praise God for all who financially support the evangelistic work of AE – may God bless them for their faithful generosity.
